Delivering growth in Plymouth

As a key enabler for delivering growth, the construction industry affects everyone, influencing productivity and well-being, creating the homes, hospitals, schools, workplaces, and infrastructure essential for a good quality of life. While the influence of construction ranges well beyond its economic impact, its contribution to our economy is substantial.

Despite the UK construction industry facing a number of current challenges including inflationary pressures, an economy still recovering from the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic which have hampered attempts to bring forward and deliver projects, the steep rise in borrowing curtailing development viability and slowing down the housebuilding sector, and innovation needed in building fabric and construction technology to drive net zero, Plymouth is facing its biggest capital spend investment in 25 years. This is being driven particularly by Devonport Royal Dockyard undergoing a significant investment in infrastructure to support the forward demands of the Royal Navy and University Hospitals Plymouth NHS Trust investing heavily to increase clinical capacity.

We recognise that construction and the built environment sector will be crucial in delivering Plymouth's ambitious capital build programme and will play a major part in the transitioning to a net zero carbon economy. This presents a tremendous opportunity for growth in the city over the coming years with more than enough work to go round, however this will inevitably create significant pressure on the existing skilled workforce and supply chain, as well as on construction tender costs. From a Building Plymouth perspective, we are certainly keen and ready to maximise these opportunities for local investment in construction skills, job creation, new green construction skills and jobs, and ensuring sustainability of local construction employment, in a time of current market uncertainty which should give confidence to those companies looking to stay, grow and invest.

Collectively employing a 9,000+ strong workforce, Plymouth has a well-established, mature and capable construction community with a breadth of expertise which makes this a very adaptable and responsive marketplace. Relationships in the city are strong across the consultants, contractors and supply chain, and Building Plymouth has enabled the whole sector to unite and join forces for the greater good.

Our Building Plymouth Expertise Directory demonstrates the strength of our local capabilities across construction and the built environment. To maximise benefits we welcome local spend to be considered a priority to keep the Plymouth pound as much as possible invested in local employment enabling sustainable growth for construction businesses. Commitment to a local spend approach will also deliver increased social impact leaving lasting legacies for our communities through our dedicated focus on achieving meaningful social value whilst we help clients to deliver these exciting projects for Plymouth.

Established in 2015, Building Plymouth is an award winning, Council-led sector skills partnership with the local construction and built environment sector, driving skills, training and employment, maximising social value and impact, and acting as a united voice for the industry.

Our vision is to close the skills gaps and skills shortages by attracting and creating a skilled supply of people to match the demand for local construction and built environment employers.

Building Plymouth is funded through an innovative public/ private partnership with over 60 member organisations co-investing during 2023/24 (see the logo summary of members on the opposite page). Together we have created a trusted and well-established infrastructure connecting the local authority, clients, contractors, subcontractors, consultants and the supply chain, as well as CITB, training providers, education institutions, Department for Work and Pensions and supporting skills agencies. This innovative public/ private sector model has been replicated widely across the southwest region and nationally and is recognised as being the blueprint for developing other city coordinated sector skills partnerships.

Facilitated by Building Plymouth, Plymouth City Council is a CITB accredited National Skills Academy for Construction committed to maximising employment and skills opportunities through local planning and procurement in Plymouth which ensures delivery of employment and skills interventions including apprenticeships, work placements, job creation and up-skilling opportunities on major developments in the city.

We recognise that competence is critical for the future of the construction industry and recruitment of sufficient numbers of competent skilled people has been a long-standing challenge for the sector, with an ageing workforce further accelerating these skills shortage issues. We are working hard together in a coordinated way to tackle the recruitment and retention challenges and improve the poor image of the industry to attract a more diverse and younger workforce, as well as to upskill the existing workforce so that they can transition from the current set of traditional occupations and skills to the new green, digitalised, modern methods of construction, and more productive competencies and jobs that the industry will need over the next decade.

Working together to maximise Social Value in Plymouth

Put simply, Social Value is the value that an organisation contributes to society beyond operational profit. Working in a coordinated way, the local construction community pro-actively invest time, resources and money to improve the quality of life, help communities thrive, and safeguard our environment.

Social Value is more than reports or figures in a spreadsheet: it is about genuine improvements in the lives of real people. Below are examples showing what Building Plymouth has been doing for our communities:

- Helped to raise over £35K for Plymouth's homelessness charity Shekinah to furnish their new centre at Stonehouse Creek, along with donations of materials and in-kind expertise to save the charity money by providing construction services
- Delivers over £111K value annually through Mission Mammoth STEAMFest Week and Awards Ceremony, a design challenge which positively connects primary school children with the world of construction and the built environment
- Hosts Early Careers Fairs to promote the local apprenticeship and graduate opportunities to the residents of Plymouth
- Celebrates the city's top trade and technical construction apprentices through Building Plymouth Awards held in National Apprenticeship Week



Coordinates BPART (Building Plymouth Aspirational Rising Talent) Network which offers construction apprentices and recent graduates access to a free 12-month CPD programme delivered in-kind by construction employers to support their development, to increase knowledge of how the industry works and to create a strong network for peer support

As well as gaining support for delivering these voluntary Social Value projects, we recognise that through embedding meaningful Social Value into procurement strategies for local construction projects this will enable the investment to go much further and direct it in a way that has the most social, economic and environmental benefits. We encourage the city's clients to unlock the Social Value opportunity inherent in every public pound spent as the local marketplace is well set up to respond positively and are committed to leaving lasting legacies from the significant construction investment.
