




KEY TO LAYOUT

APPRENTICESHIP ROLES WITHIN THIS BULLETIN EXPLAINED

Administration / Business Administration

Deliver the practical and/or clerical support necessary to ensure the smooth running of general business operations or specific tasks and projects.

Building Services Engineer

Building Services Engineers install, maintain and often design the systems that make buildings safe, convenient and comfortable.

Building Services Technician

Building Services Technicians help engineers design, plan and install electrical and mechanical systems within buildings.

Building Surveyor

Survey buildings to assess their condition and structure, providing advice on repairs or proposed renovations or alterations.

Bricklayer

Lay bricks, pre-cut stone, concrete blocks and other types of building blocks in mortar to construct and repair walls, foundations, partitions, arches and other structures.

Carpenter

Carpenters and joiners make and install wooden fixtures and fittings as part of construction projects.

Civil Engineer

Civil engineers have the important role of planning, designing and managing construction projects.

Demolition Operative

Demolition operatives dismantle old and derelict structures or buildings.

Dryliner

Create the walls and rooms in a building. They also hide pipes and wires, create space for insulation and smooth out uneven surfaces during renovation work.

Electrician

Install, inspect and test electrical equipment, making sure everything in a building works properly and safely.

Electrical and Mechanical Engineer

'M&E' in construction refers to mechanical and electrical systems. The term is often taken to be interchangeable with 'building services'/ 'building services engineer'

APPRENTICESHIP ROLES WITHIN THIS BULLETIN EXPLAINED

Engineering Technician

A key part of the design and construction team, working alongside a wider design and construction team.

Fenestration / PVCU Fabricator

Fenestration is the fabricating and assembly of windows, doors and other openings to buildings.

Flooring / Floor Layer

Floor Layers are trained in laying floor coverings and floor finishes.

Landscaping and Horticulture

The creation and upkeep of places for people to live, work and play and places for plants and animals to thrive.

Multi-Trade Operative

Multi-trade operatives cover a multitude of trades within construction including carpentry, painting and decorating, bricklaying and plastering

Painter and Decorator

Painters and Decorators work on a wide range of painting and decorating jobs, ranging from simple house renovations all the way to maintaining historic buildings.

Plasterer

The plasterer is indispensable to most building sites – making walls and ceilings smooth and ready for decorating.

Quantity Surveyor / Cost Consultant

Quantity surveyors work out exactly how much a building costs to construct and are in charge of finances.

Scaffolder

Scaffolders erect and dismantle temporary metal structures, usually around buildings, which allow other construction trades to carry out their jobs safely.

Structural Engineer

Structural engineers design structures to withstand stresses and pressures imposed through environmental conditions and human use.




